Proof of Legal Resident Status in Canada

Under the Housing Services Act, each person on the application form must be a Canadian Citizen, has made application for status as a Landed Immigrant or Permanent Resident or claim for protection as a Refugee under the Immigration and Refugee Protection Act, with no deportation order, departure order or exclusion order.

Here are some suggestions to help you meet this requirement:

Canadian Citizens

- Birth Certificate from a Canadian province or territory
- Canadian Certificate of Registration of Birth Abroad
- Certified Statement of Live Birth from a Canadian province or territory
- Certificate of Canadian Citizenship or Certificate of Naturalization (paper document or card, not commemorative issue)
- Certificate of Indian Status (paper or plastic card)
- Registered Indian Record (certified)
- Valid Canadian Passport
- Certificate of retention (issued between Jan 1. 2947 Feb 14, 1977)

Permanent Residents / Landlord Immigrants

- Canadian Immigration Identification Card
- Confirmation of Permanent Residence
- Valid Permanent Resident Card
- Record of Landing

Other Immigration Status

- Written confirmation from the Immigration, Refugees and Citizenship Canada (IRCC) stating that you are "approved in principle (AIP)" for permanent resident status.
- A letter from IRCC confirming Convention Refugee or Protected Person status
