Architectural Description: two storey yellow brick with a hip roof and a centre peak; first floor; large rectangular window with a round headed transom containing stained glass on the left side and an entrance door on the right; the hipped roof porch is supported by round columns and has a turned balustrade; second floor has three segmentally arched one over one paned windows the centre window is closed with shutters; there are brackets under eaves and a round window in the peak. The left side has segmentally arched window on each floor at the right side and a three sided two storey bay window to the left; each window in each section of the bay window are segmentally arched one over one pane. The right hand side of the house has had a frame two storey enclosed porch added on.

The house was built for Edmund Tyndal Dufton, who managed the Dufton Woolen Mills. James L. Killoran, a judge of Perth County lived in this house in 1927.
