Architectural Description: Former Stratford Fairgrounds entrance. Erected by a local mason to mark the 1941 centennial of the Stratford Agricultural Society (construction delayed due to wartime constraints). Large fieldstone Gates, Gate Posts and Pylon, all with square beaded mortar. Pylon includes flagpole and bronze plaque presented by the Ontario Department of Agriculture to commemorate and honour the work and achievements of the Society.

The Stratford Fairgrounds was an important cultural feature for Stratford and the neighbouring agricultural community for 130 years, hosing the annual Stratford Fair and numerous other events. The Entrance Gates are the last remaining evidence of the Fairgrounds and its significance to the history of Stratford and the surrounding area.
