Architectural Description: Two and a half storey red brick house with soldier course over windows. House features an asymmetrical roofline and a front facing gable with fish scale design on its shingles. Verandah features a pediment as well as a tongue and groove ceiling

357 St. David Street was erected for the builder, William Schenck, in 1916. Robert S. Rodgers, foreman of the CNR blacksmith shop, later owned this house between 1927 and 1967.

House is located in an area that features an interesting mix of historic houses sized similarly to 357 St. David Street as well as much larger, grander homes.
