**Architectural Description:** One storey yellow brick; gable roof with centre peak over front door; round window in gable; centre entrance door with segmentally arched opening; transom divided into three sections; door has sidelights; large two over two segmentally arched windows with voussoirs over windows; shutters at side of windows; original molded fascia and soffits; a band of raised brick work under eaves and at the corners of the wall

The house was owned by William Trethewey, the yard master of the Grand Trunk Railway shops.
