After years of anticipation, two new transportation services will begin in 2020. We would like you tell us about your transportation needs so that we can plan them to serve you.




The Intercity Service will link Stratford, St. Marys, and Listowel with Kitchener-Waterloo, and Stratford and St. Marys with London.














Route 2: Connects Mitchell, Sebringville, St. Mary's and Stratford to each other.



The City held seven 1-hour Community Transportation Focus Groups on 8 and 10 October to gather initial feedback from our Community Stakeholders.


We asked each group what they want and need from the proposed intercommunity transportation service; what barriers would keep the service from working effectively for them; and asked how this service would help them.






The City and the County conducted a Community Transportation Survey from 20 September to 14 October 2019. We received over 1860 responses from across the County. Here is what we learned:





Age Demographics: Who Responded?

What do they want to use this service for?






How often do they want to go?
