DECLARATION OF CRIMINAL CONVICTIONS UNDER FEDERAL LAW

(Does not constitute a Certified Criminal Record by the RCMP and may not contain all criminal record convictions)

DO NOT DECLARE:

- Absolute Discharges or Conditional Discharges, pursuant to the Criminal Code, Section 730.
- Any charges for which you have received a Record Suspension, pursuant to the Criminal Records Act.
- Any offences while you were a "Young Person" (12 years old but less than 18 years old), pursuant to the Youth Criminal Justice Act.
- Any charges for which you were not convicted, for example: charges that were withdrawn dismissed, etc.
- Any Provincial or Municipal offences.
- Any charges dealt with outside of Canada.

Note: A certified Criminal Record can only be issued based on the submission of fingerprints to the RCMP National Repository of Criminal Records.
